# We Are Ready for the General Election ... Are You?



If you haven't yet, now is the time to make your plan to vote and make sure you are #VoteReady. Visit [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov) to register to vote, update your information, request a Vote By Mail ballot, find Early Voting locations, look up your Election Day polling place and many other things. Can't find something? Give us a call at (813) 744-5900 - we are always happy to help!

**IMPORTANT: Deadline to register to vote is October 7!**

*If you are already registered to vote in Florida, you can update your address anytime, even on Election Day.*

## Three Ways to Vote

1

### Vote By Mail: Due no later than November 5 at 7 PM

Visit [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov), give us a call or swing by my office if you want to request a Vote By Mail ballot. The deadline to make a request is 5 PM on October 24, but don't wait that long!



Once received, mark your ballot, sign the return envelope and drop it in the mail. (*We pay the return postage.*) Or, drop it off in person in a Secure Ballot Intake Station at any of my Early Voting sites (*during Early Voting hours*) or any of my offices when they're open.

*Note: You should allow at least a week for your ballot to reach my office by mail.*

- U.S. Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID (issued by VA)
- Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06)
- Government Employee ID
