# We Are Ready for the General Election ... Are You?



If you haven't yet, now is the time to make your plan to vote and make sure you are #VoteReady. Visit **VoteHillsborough.gov** to register to vote, update your information, request a Vote By Mail ballot, find Early Voting locations, look up your Election Day polling place and many other things. Can't find something? Give us a call at (813) 744-5900 – we are always happy to help!

#### **IMPORTANT:** Deadline to register to vote is October 7!

If you are already registered to vote in Florida, you can update your address anytime, even on Election Day.

## Three Ways to Vote



### **Vote By Mail**: Due no later than November 5 at 7 PM



Visit **VoteHillsborough.gov**, give us a call or swing by my office if you want to request a Vote By Mail ballot. The deadline to make a request is 5 PM on October 24, but don't wait that long!

Once received, mark your ballot, sign the return envelope and drop it in the mail. (*We pay the return postage*.) Or, drop it off in person in a Secure Ballot Intake Station at any of my Early Voting sites (*during Early Voting hours*) or any of my offices when they're open.

Note: You should allow at least a week for your ballot to reach my office by mail.



### Early Voting: October 21 - November 3, 7 AM - 7 PM



Pick the time and place that works best for you — and bring your friends and family, too. Vote at any of the 27 Early Voting sites in Hillsborough County during the Early Voting period (even on the weekends!).

- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID (issued by VA)
- Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06)
- Government Employee ID
