It's Time To VOTE







In Florida, there are three ways to cast your ballot: Vote By Mail, Early Voting and Election Day.

Vote By Mail: Due no later than August 20 at 7 PM



The deadline to request a Vote By Mail ballot was August 8th. If your ballot is ready to go, make sure to drop it in the mail as soon as possible. We pay the return postage! Or, drop it in a Secure Ballot Intake Station at any of my offices or **Early Voting sites** (when they're open).

Don't forget to seal, sign and date the envelope.

Early Voting: August 5-18, 10 AM - 6 PM



Pick the time and place that works best for you. Vote in person at any of the **27 Early Voting sites** in Hillsborough County anytime during the Early Voting period (even on the weekends!)

3 Election Day: August 20, 7 AM - 7 PM



Election Day is your LAST chance to vote. On Election Day, you must vote in your assigned polling place.

Why Are There Partisan Candidates On My Nonpartisan Ballot?

If all candidates in a race for a partisan office are of the same party and will be unopposed in the General Election, the race is considered a Universal Primary Contest and will be on everyone's ballot. In the upcoming Primary Election, there will be a Universal Primary Contest for Public Defender on the ballot.

What to Bring When Voting in Person



- Florida Driver License
- Florida ID Card (issued by the Dept. of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles)
- · U.S. Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID

- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID (issued by VA)
- Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06)
- Government Employee ID

I also recommend you bring your Sample Ballot with you to the polls for reference. **Find yours at VoteHillsborough.gov/MySampleBallot.**

You don't have to wait. Cast your ballot early!
