Four Hillsborough County Elections Offices will Reopen Monday, October 14

Hillsborough County, FL – Supervisor of Elections Craig Latimer is announcing that these four elections offices will be open normal hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., beginning Monday, October 14th:

- Robert L. Gilder Elections Service Center, 2514 N. Falkenburg Rd
- Fred B. Karl County Center, 601 E. Kennedy Blvd, 16th floor
- Southeast Regional Office, 10020 South U.S. Hwy 301
- Northwest Regional Office, 4575 Gunn Hwy

The SouthShore Regional Service Center is expected to open soon but will remain closed until the facility can be further assessed.

"We are three weeks from Election Day and have been doing everything possible to make our offices and services available for voters," said Supervisor Latimer. "Some offices may have limited services and we appreciate everyone's patience during this challenging time."

Secure Ballot Intake Stations where voters can drop off their voted Vote By Mail ballots are located inside the offices and are available during office hours. Voters who have returned their mail ballots can track them at VoteHillsborough.gov.

Voters who have been displaced by the storms may need a ballot mailed to a new address. It is recommended that they call the elections office at (813) 612-4180 to expedite this request. If they can't call, voters can visit one of the four offices in person or send an email to <u>VoteByMail@VoteHillsborough.gov</u> requesting a ballot to a new address. To make the request, voters must include their Florida driver license or state ID number or the last four digits of their social security number.

Voters can also visit one of the elections offices to pick up a Vote By Mail ballot in person. They can then fill out the ballot and drop it in a Secure Ballot Intake Station at those offices, or take it home and return it later.

Preliminary assessments of Early Voting locations have been completed and Supervisor Latimer confirms that Early Voting will take place in Hillsborough County October 21 – November 3, 7 am to 7 pm, as scheduled. Any necessary location changes will be shared in the upcoming week. The office is continuing to assess Election Day locations for their availability, as well.
